- Sleeping bags provided by the charter company

- American currency or travelers cheques for pocket money
- Credit cards
- Safe place to stow your valuable loot
- Sun Block cream (30 or better)
- Sun Glasses with retention cord
- shorts & T-shirts & trunks
- extra-loud Caribbean T-shirt to blend in on shore
- favourite music CD's
- A good enough camera
- Towel
- Pillow Case (handy for bringing back soiled laundry)
- Aspirin
- Current passport
